## FIRST PAGE

FORMAT

Double space, centered, and use a standard typeface and type size, such as 12-point Times New Roman.

Name of Faculty Advisor

Project Timeline

PAGE HEADER

A page header includes page number. Headers should appear in the top right corner of every page.

## REFERENCES

TITLE

The title "References" should be aligned to the left, but not underlined or punctuated.

NUMERICAL ORDER

Numerically arrange works cited.

## CITATION GUIDELINES

Papers written in Vancouver format require endnotes and a Bibliography page.

Use the following formats for the most common types of sources.

N = Note Format and R = Reference Format.

## BOOK BY A SINGLE AUTHOR

N Cited text. (endnote number)

The book, "Secrets from the black bag", by Butler <sup>1</sup> shows that .....

OR

Butler <sup>1</sup> purported '.....'

R Endnote Number. Last Name, Initials. Title. Location: Publisher; Year.

## BOOK BY TWO TO SIX AUTHORS

N Cited text. (endnote number)

'..... needed to influence policy.'<sup>2</sup>

OR

Cheers, Darracott and Lonne have highlighted the fact that '.....'<sup>2</sup>

R Endnote Number. Last Name, Initials, Last Name, Initials, Last Name, Initials. Title. Location: Publisher; Year.

## BOOK WITH NO AUTHOR GIVEN

N Cited text. (endnote number)
